Nominated and kept eligible by payment
\$50 to pass entry box and \$100 to start. Supplemental nomination fee 20% of the estimated gross purse payable at time of entry.

SIX FURLONGS

Two-year old fillies foaled in Oregon
Scheduled to run in the late fall at Portland Meadows
Nominated and kept eligible by payment
\$50 to pass entry box and \$100 to start. Supplemental nomination fee 20% of the estimated gross purse payable at time of entry.

Weights for Two-year-olds: Equal weight of 120 lbs.

Weights for Three-year-olds:

Equal weight of 121 lbs., 5 poundilly allowance (116 lbs) in mixed sex stakes

Total purse monies to be divided as follows:

1st-55%, 2nd-20%, 3rd-15%, 4th-7.5%, 5th-2.5%

The OTOBA Board of Directors may change any condition or term regarding these races at any time. If a race fails to fill or is not run for any reason the OTOBA Board may at it's discretion, run the race at another track or date, or cancel the race. If cancellation occurs the OTOBA may be required only to refund the nominations paid at that time in accordance with policy of the board

The rules of the Oregon State Racing Commission in effect at the time the race is run govern all races run under the auspices of the commercial race meet operator at Portland Meadows.

Entries to any or all of the races advertised in this blank will be received only with the understanding, and on the agreement of the subscriber that the provision of racing rules form a part of and govern the contract.

Every person entering a horse in a race to be run under these rules accepts the decision of the stewards on any question relating to a race or to racing.

At the discretion of the stewards and without notice, the entries of any person or the transfer of any entry may be refused.

It is understood that the above horse or horses so entered will only be allowed to start if in good standing at the time of the actual running of this event. Entries are made with the understanding that said nomination does not assure stall space for horses nominated prior to the actual running of the stake in which nominated. The Oregon Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association reserves the right to cancel this event without notice at any time prior to the actual running thereof, without liability, except for the return of the nomination fees.

The racing association may televise or authorize or license the televising of certain horse racing to be conducted in its racing plan from time to time and, accordingly, it hereby reserves television rights, whether in connection with any race, preparations therefor, or training at the track. This application is accepted on the condition that, if required, consent is hereby given, and the owner, jockey, trainer, groom and all other employees of the owner coming within the view of the television picture hereby agree to sign and deliver to the racing association and race meet operator upon demand, release permitting such television and the exhibition thereof.

The OTOBA is not responsible for mistakes made on this nomination form; mistakes are the sole responsibility of the nominator. Nominations to the stakes races contained hereon are for Oregon-bred horses only.

Special Conditions for OTOBA Stakes to Prevent Spoils in Major Races

Order of preference: Handicap and Stake winners of \$3000 or more to the winner have first preference, Handicap and Stake winners of less than \$3000 to the winner have second preference, third preference to Handicap and Stakes Place winners, fourth preference to horse with most number of wins, fifth preference to Stake Place Maidens, sixth preference to Maidens by money earned
